

# **MEETING AT THE DOOR**



Meeting at the Door (MATD) is a Yokefellowship Prison Ministry (YPM) Delaware Valley Area Council program. MATD is created to assist those being paroled or maxing out from any Pennsylvania State Prison.

We offer transportation on the day of release, the first non-prison meal, clothing, a pre-paid cell phone with 120 minutes, and references for other social and governmental services as needed. **Only if we can assist you with transportation will certain services be provided.** 

MATD requires that the incarcerated person fill out our Intake Form. We ask that you be at least three to six months away from your anticipated release date. **Exceptions may be made with sufficient advanced notice and where resources are available.** As mentioned on our Intake Form, mentoring can be requested, and we will attempt to provide that service when resources permit.

In the event you have your own transportation, MATD may still be able to provide you with some clothing and make referrals. Yokefellowship Prison Ministry operates across Pennsylvania. We encourage any Pennsylvania State Prisoner to contact us to see if we can help through YPM's Meeting at the Door program.
